ASSET BASED INFRASTRUCTURE

 Provide incentives packages targeted at job creation and privatesector investment in vacant land ripe for redevelopment (e.g., suburban office parks, brownfields).



OPA and NJTPA will incentivize mixed-use centers with multiple transportation options allows the public to get around to their jobs, homes, and activities by walking – improving public health outcomes.

- Action 1: Apply criteria of designated growth areas, TOD locations and distressed areas as described in the State Development and Redevelopment Plan and New Jersey Economic Opportunity Act (EOA) to select potential underutilized sites.
- Action 2: Incentivize county/municipal participation in the identification of sites with funding under the NJTPA's Planning for Emerging Centers grant programs
- Action 3: Support corporate campus redevelopments such as Sanofi site initiative and apply success stories elsewhere.
- Action 4: Amend the Economic Opportunity Act to prioritize to "smart-growth locations consistent with market demand shifts towards redevelopment.
